We have compiled, what we think is accurate, based on labels we have read, and have come up with a chart to make it easier for you. We are not changing our prices and what we call certain weight yarns, but you can use this chart to see where your skeins of yarn fall. We always put your ypp= yards per pound- next to the fleece we spin, on your invoice, so you always know what it is. From your invoice you can then look at the yards per pound and all the information we have compiled for you. Wpi= wraps per inch</p>
